SAVE THE DATE: NOV. 10, FREE AG-NATURE TOURISM WORKSHOP FOR FRESNO AND TULARE COUNTIES

NORTH FORK, CA – YOSEMITE/SEQUOIA RESOURCE CONSERVATION & DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (Y/S RC&D) in conjunction with its sponsors and partners are pleased to announce the *Growing Your Ag-Nature Tourism Business* free workshop series for Ag-Nature entrepreneurs in Fresno and Tulare Counties.

The first of three workshops will be on Thursday, November 10, 2011 from 9a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Tulare County Board of Supervisors Chambers (2800 W. Burrel Avenue, Visalia CA). These workshops, funded by the Sierra Nevada Conservancy, have been specifically designed for farmers, ranchers, bed and breakfasts, wineries and other outdoor, recreational and nature entrepreneurs within Fresno and Tulare counties.

The November 10th workshop will include speakers, presenters and panelists who have found success cultivating Ag-Nature Tourism enterprises. Topics to be presented will include: (1) Exploring if Ag-Nature Tourism is Right for You, (2) Creating a Business Plan, (3) Legal Issues and Risk Management, (4) Marketing Your New Endeavor, and (5) Tools and Resources to be Successful.

The November 10th workshop will be followed by two additional full day components - one in Fresno County and one in Tulare County (date to be determined). Here participants will go on a

working model tour of existing Ag- Nature business and learn the ins-and-outs of running a

successful Ag-Nature business.

YS/ RC&D will be utilizing their website as well as social media techniques to assure that all

participants have easy access to all training materials before and after the workshops. In

addition, participants will have access to the Central Valley Business Incubators (CVBI) planning

portal, VIP (Virtual Incubator Program) for 12 months (\$100.00 value per-participant). Major

emphasis will be placed on providing all attendees access to personalized one-on-one business

counseling services provided through the CVBI Small Business Development Center (SBDC).

Y/S RC&D is a quasi governmental nonprofit organization that focuses on natural resource

conservation and economic development practices. It is the mission of Y/S RC&D Council to

promote the quality and aesthetic values of our cultural, environmental, and recreational

resources by improving quality of life through diverse sustainable economic development. The
