 Yield 4th year - 1.8 lbs/plant (2010) 7th year - 3.8 lbs/plant (2013) 10th year - 7.6 lbs/plant (2016) Notes Well-known, well-loved Native diseases Wooly elm aphids, thrips leaf & berry spot fungus, rust Hand harvest mid-July Martin, Thiessen, JB30 - recommended 	







Wooly Elm Aphid

- Among the most destructive pests of Juneberry
 - Can destroy the roots of Juneberry esp new plantings
 - Aphids migrate from elms in mid-June to early July
 - Net new plantings
 - Ladybugs and syrphid flies
 - Systemic insecticides
 - Diatomaceous earth?
